 - distributed at Open House and discussed at Parent/Teacher Conferences and posted on school's website
- Annual Education Report
 - posted on the school's website
- Date and time of Annual Title I Parent Meeting
 - Information is available upon request
- Student Academic Achievement on state assessments
 - MEAP, MEAP-Access, and MI Access scores are sent through the US Mail when they are available from the state. Usually around March.
- Limited English Proficient (LEP) program participation
 - If your student is assigned to this English instruction program, you will be notified not later than 30 days after the beginning of the school year.
